Annually, IRs (Intergroup Reps) distribute sign-up sheets for members to serve on IG committees.</p> <p>3. TSW Committee plans at least 2 trips yearly to visit small meetings or meetings in outlying areas to carry the message from Intergroup (asks for volunteers to go along).</p> <p>3. IR Trainer annually shares the 7<sup>th</sup> tradition pamphlets with IRs to share in their meetings.</p> <p>3.
